The 2013 Training Program in Prevention and Surveillance of Birth Defects and Preterm Birth will take place on 27 to 31 May 2013, at WHO Headquarters in Geneva, Switzerland, with Faculty from ICBDSR, CDC, and WHO. By the deadline (31 Jan), 41 applications were received, and up to 27 trainees will be selected. New to the 2013 program is a distance-based module on selected key areas (epidemiology, birth defects, prevention), to maximize the learning experience at the face-to-face week in May.
