Use of Special Education Services among Children with Congenital Heart Defects

New CDC study findings in *Pediatrics* show that children with <u>congenital heart defects</u> (CHDs) received special education services more often than children without birth defects. These findings highlight the need for special education services and the importance of <u>developmental screening</u> for all children with CHDs, with involvement from state policymakers and school systems.
