Kutná Hora

Kutná Hora is a small city in central Bohemia that was an important center of medieval Bohemian kingdom – because of the rich silver mines. We will visit the Sedlec monastery with its famous ossuary and also historical buildings, where we will see the exposition of the museum of historical mining. We will also have the chance to see the historical mine in all its glory. The lunch will be served in traditional Czech restaurant in historical building.

Notes:

- *Three different 3-course menus will be available for lunch selection.*
- *Drinks are not included in the lunch price, but will be offered for a reasonable price.*
- *The tour includes a visit of a historical mine where visitors will be equipped with a lamp, helmet and mining kirtle with hood to go through a 250 m medieval gallery. Please note that people suffering from claustrophobia, cardiac and respiratory diseases, pregnant women and people with reduced mobility are not allowed to enter the mine.*
