The **UK Government** and devolved administrations are seeking views on the **proposal to introduce mandatory fortification of flour with folic acid.** This is to help reduce neural tube defects (NTDs) in fetuses by raising the folate levels of women who could become pregnant. The course has been developed by the International Centre on Birth Defects (ICBD Centre) and supported, in part, by funding from the National Center on Birth Defects and Developmental Disabilities, US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, through Agreement 2016-2017 with the Task Force for Global Health. The course is designed for clinicians, epidemiologists, public health professionals, and anyone interested in understanding birth defects and improving their prevention and care.
